There are seven distinct components that support students year-round, and one of these is pre-teaching in the summer.

About The Position

Teachers who thrive at TCP love kids, are dedicated to their craft, embrace feedback, and constantly seek to build connections. As a summer teacher you will have 20-25 students and you will pre-teach the skills and concepts that they will be learning in the first semester in the fall. You will potentially have a student peer teacher to support your work. In addition to teaching mathematics you will chaperone students on field trips and will teach team building and career-exploration activities planned by TCP.

Responsibilities

- Plan and implement math curriculum with middle or high school students
- Maintain regular communication with program supervisor and parents regarding student progress
- Develop formative and summative measurement tools to better evaluate student progression
- Attend 1 paid workshop on planning and developing curricula and lessons (using our collected materials as well as your own materials)

- Bachelor's Degree
- Teaching experience and experience working with adolescents preferred
- Experience working effectively with students and staff of various cultures and linguistic backgrounds
- Creativity and ability to foster curiosity and excitement about learning mathematics
